Circle Garden: Tulips breaking ground but no color yet

Bulb Garden: Snowdrops, Meadow Cranesbill, daffodils

Home Landscape: Daffodils

Crescent Garden: Nothing as of this writing, but one of the first areas to receive annual plants since it's the first garden after the Visitor Center.

Heritage Garden: Planting beds that surround the central fountain are now being prepared.

Rose Garden: Soil preparation underway

Sensory and Enabling Gardens: Area maintenance has begun.

Seems that spring will be rather late in arriving this year. There is very little bloom activity on the crabapple trees that line the north side of the Great Basin.
